

# COMMUNITY OF CHRIST PEACE AWARD

The Community of Christ Peace Award (CoCPA) is a monetary amount given to the winning recipient to acknowledge and encourage the highest standards of promoting peacemaking in the student's personal life, their home life, their school life and their community life. The eligible student(s) will be a high school graduate from the Lambton-Kent District School Board (within Kent County boundaries), and continuing their education either at college or university level in the fall. The award will be given to graduates, who have promoted the **concept of Peace** through specific achievements and/or opportunities during his/her school years. Up to \$3000 will be given to the recipient(s) for this school year.

## **Purpose:**

- to promote an awareness of and actions leading to peace in the student's own life, family life, school life and community life
- to reward a graduating senior with a peace award for the attitude and actions demonstrating and promoting peace
- to encourage their peers to become peacemakers personally and corporately that all will benefit from an expanding core of peaceful students in their community

## **Peace Award:**

- the complete the application form and describe peace in their own life and their relationships with their family, school and community
- the successful student(s) is selected by a committee composed of 3 or more judges
- a formal presentation to the winner will be made at the Community of Christ in June and acknowledged at graduation ceremonies.
- funds guaranteed by the sponsoring organization of the Community of Christ Peace Award, Community of Christ

## **Timeline:**

- submit goals and objectives to Chairperson.
- deadline April 30
- Judges will select the peacemaker award recipient through a personal interview, at the Community of Christ. Interviews will be conducted on the 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> Thursdays in May, beginning at 6:30. Please be available for one of these evenings.
- all student applicants will be informed by phone/mail for this year's winning recipient.
- the award is not about a writing contest but about developing and encouraging exemplary community citizens and honouring their achievements.
