Travel Documents:

Passport:

<u>Passports are mandatory</u>. Anyone without a current passport will not be allowed to cross the border. IF YOU DO NOT HAVE A CURRENT PASSPORT >>> APPLY IMMEDIATELY<<

Permission to Travel Form:

Parents/guardians MUST complete the attached permission form authorizing their youth to travel out of Canada. Permission forms do not need to be notarized.

Insurance:

All campers must have out-of-country insurance. Travel insurance is required from July 12-21, 2024. This is for coverage in case you need the services of a hospital. It is the camper's responsibility to arrange for travel insurance while out of the country.

For minor medical emergencies there are doctors and nurses at the Infirmary at SPEC with no additional cost to us.

Packing Tips:

Label all your personal items!

The weather during SPEC is **VERY** hot and humid. The staff will bring laundry soap.

- ONE PIECE OF LUGGAGE PER CAMPER. Due to space, the bus can only fit one suitcase each.
- Pillow, sheets, blanket (recommended rather than sleeping bag due to extreme heat and humidity)
- Air mattress for Church stays (we will be sleeping on the floor).
- Towel, swimsuit, sunscreen, hat, water bottle
- Sports shoes and equipment (ie. shin pads, knee pads, cleats, gloves, tennis racquets etc.)
- Black athletic shorts for team uniform
- Gym bag or back pack
- Clothing* (Spec holds a strict dress code: no shirtless, no crop tops, no short shorts)
- Light jacket or sweater (just in case)
- Medications (let us know if you are bringing any)
- Toiletries (soap, shampoo, toothbrush, toothpaste, brush, deodorant, etc.)

*Remember that campers will receive a jersey with the delegation logo on it plus 2 Canadian delegation t-shirts. **You must provide your own shorts, preferably black**). When participating in sports, campers must wear the delegation jersey. Campers are asked to wear a delegation t-shirt at other specific times during the week (ie. group picture day).

Spending Money

- Please ensure your teen has money in both USD and CDN. There will not be an opportunity or place to exchange money.
- 3 mall stops in total for snacks, souvenirs and shopping items, if you wish.
- **Meals while traveling** (approx. 1 breakfast, 3 lunch meals, and 2 suppers). Campers should have approximately \$75 USD to cover meals (at \$15 per meal) plus additional funds for snacks.
- The dining hall is open continually during SPEC for the campers' nourishment and there is no cost (included in fees). There are vending machines and a snack bar on site (for cost).
- Please bring offering money for worship services at SPEC
- Ensure cell phone roaming plans are updated or phone cards purchased to avoid expensive roaming charges.

Each camper is responsible for how they manage their spending money
